Roots Community Enhancement is a Community Interest Company in Dawlish, serving the town, Teignmouth and surrounding villages. The organisation, run not for profit but for the good of the community, aims to meet community needs identified following cuts in services over the last few years. Formed in 2018 and led by a registered mental health nurse, the volunteers provide services for local people on a free or donation

basis to ensure access for all (thanks to The National Lottery Community Fund).

They offer baby massage courses, a baby group, a multi-generational play group, a bereavement support group, a peer support platform for Mums and six week HOPE course looking at wellbeing whilst living with long term conditions (which they run for Torbay NHS Trust). They also run events to enhance the local community such as stress workshops, pop up laughter yoga and music/making sessions. Continuing to operate during lockdowns, they created online groups, daily videos and sent out over 1000 activity packs to those who were isolating, shielding or struggling day to day.
